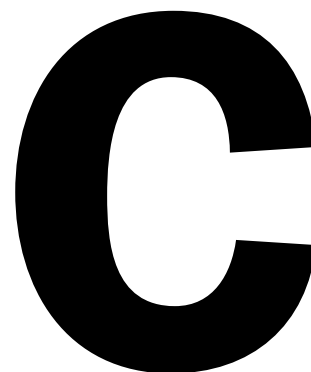
Sabadell’s Commitment to Sustainability

With the aim of recognising the best young researcher talent in Spain and highlighting the impact of their lines of research in people's wellbeing, every year the Banco Sabadell Foundation gives out various awards to celebrate knowledge, innovation and talent in the fields of economics, biomedicine, science and engineering, as well as marine sustainability.

22nd Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Economic Research

The Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Economic Research, which receives applications every year since 2002, aims to foster and recognise the work of Spanish researchers in the fields of economic, business and social knowledge, and to contribute to the analysis and creation of new alternatives that promote social welfare.

The panel of judges of this edition recognised the work of Dr Joan Monràs, Research Advisor at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco and Economics Professor at Pompeu Fabra University for his innovative research works in immigration. His lines of research focus on the fields of labour economics, urban economics and international trade. His articles study the effects of immigration on the labour market and how local economies can adjust to economic shocks and changing politics.

People who have influenced the way I think about economics, who have inspired me and whose careers I have followed. All this makes the award extremely meaningful to me. 18th Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Biomedical Research

The Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Biomedical Research recognises the excellence of young scientists with an outstanding track record in the fields of biomedicine and health sciences who stand out in their respective specialties for their ability to innovate.

The panel of judges of this edition recognised the work of Dr Manuel Valiente, PhD in Neurosciences and Brain Metastasis Group Lead at the Spanish National Cancer Research Centre (CNIO) for his contributions on mechanisms that generate brain metastasis, the identification of therapeutic targets and their potential use in the selection of patients according to their response to treatment.

“This award has a lot of different meanings for me: firstly, it confirms that the initial risk of committing to a laboratory dedicated to brain metastasis, a terminal condition for which there have been zero expectations for years now, has paid off, as it is proving to be a field with many opportunities for improvement. Secondly, it is further proof to me that tenacity is crucial and that, along with motivation, it is an unbeatable antidote against the difficulties that we encounter during our scientific careers”.

7th Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Sciences and Engineering

The Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Sciences and Engineering, organised together with the Barcelona Institute of Science and Technology (BIST), recognises the work of young researchers who stand out in the fields of mathematics, chemistry, physics and engineering.

The panel of judges of this edition gave the award to Dr Juan Miguel Morales, PhD in Industrial Engineering and Team Lead of Optimization and Analytics for Sustainable Energy Systems (OASYS) at the University of Malaga, for his career track record focused on the development of computational tools for the deployment of distributed renewable energy resources.

“Receiving this award marks a momentous milestone in my career; it represents years of hard work, dedication and passion for scientific research. I am so proud and grateful that the judges have valued a trajectory like mine, which combines elements of engineering and applied mathematics, exploring and unlocking connections between theory and practice”.

2nd Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Marine Sustainability

The Banco Sabadell Foundation Award for Marine Sustainability recognises the work of Spanish scientists in the fields of marine environmental regeneration and the sustainable use of its resources and, specifically, those research works that provide tangible evidence of their applicability and impact.

The panel of judges of this edition recognised Dra Elena Ojea for her work on the adaptation and transformation of marine socio-ecological systems and the assessment of climate change risks and vulnerabilities. Elena Ojea's research focuses on the adaptative solutions for marine socio-ecological systems, which enable the sustainable management of resources, social equality and the preservation of marine-related livelihoods.

“This award is a unique opportunity for young researchers that work in cross-cutting fields that oftentimes do not fit the traditional scientific system. By paying attention to marine sustainability and giving awards for research, we can go further. It brings me joy to be recognised by a scientific community that I deeply admire and to know that I am part of a big collective effort that is impacting the sustainability of oceans”.

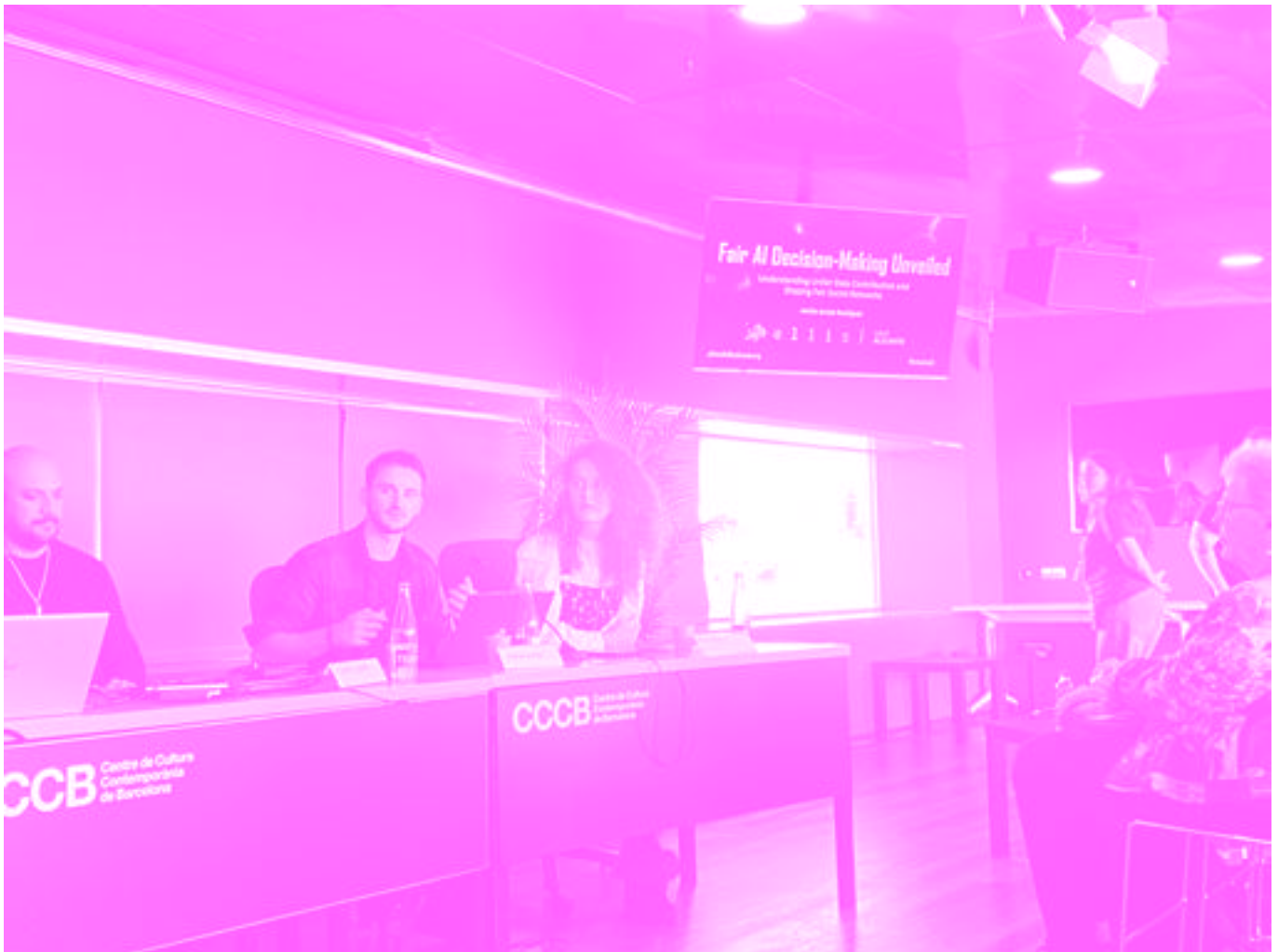

CENTRE DE CULTURA CONTEMPORÀNIA DE BARCELONA (CCCB) ‘Societats algorítmiques’ interdisciplinary space for debate

The CCCB’s thought and literature programme promotes reflection and knowledge through the free exchange of ideas, people and disciplines. It proposes an interdisciplinary approach and includes the perspective of global leading philosophers, sociologists, scientists, artists, writers, anthropologists and journalists.



FUNDACIÓ DEL GRAN TEATRE DEL LICEU '(Oh!)pera. Newly created micro-operas' programme, part of the 2023/2024 theatre season

Artistic creation support project, part of the Liceu's theatre season, to promote the experimentation and learning of students of various design disciplines of the city through a real opera creation experience, which results in the development and premiere of four short-format operas that are performed on the same evening in various areas of the theatre.

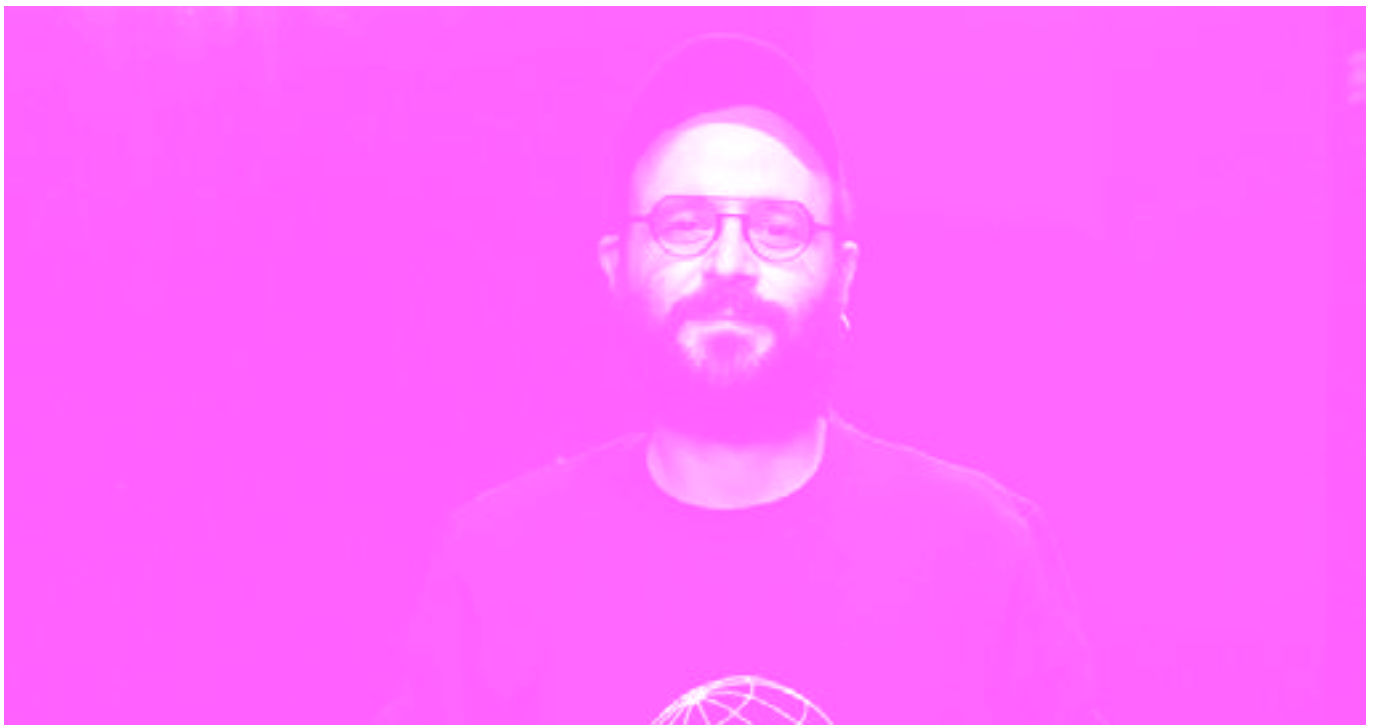

‘Escuela Dentro Cine’ is an experimental project for art education through cinema aimed at disadvantaged young people aged 16 to 23, with the dual purpose of training them in the practice and language of cinematography, and of providing them with tools for dialogue, self-exploration, expression, empowerment and knowledge.

Young Talents series and ‘Crescendo. Creamos Ópera’ programme

The Young Talents series consists of a programme of concerts performed and mediated by young talented individuals from ESMRS, with a repertoire linked to the operas on Teatro Real’s programme, and subsequent colloquiums between musicians and the audience. The ‘Crescendo’ programme is a national initiative aiming to offer training and professional opportunities to promising young people in the area of opera creation as part of a commitment to promote a diverse and inclusive artistic ecosystem.

The 'Jove Orquestra Simfònica del Vallès' brings together each year music students from all Catalonia to participate in an intensive, one-week event where they attend training sessions, classes, workshops and talks with professors and the conductor of 'Orquestra Simfònica del Vallès' and other guests.



FUNDACIÓ ÒPERA CATALUNYA (FOC) OSV Academy

Selected students from the 'Jove Orquestra Simfònica del Vallès' have the opportunity to join the OSV Academy and take part in various symphony concerts during the OSV's regular season with the aim of introducing students to professional practice and of creating a new culture of orchestral practice.



FUNDACIÓ ÒPERA CATALUNYA (FOC) 'Òpera a Catalunya' series

The 'Òpera a Catalunya' series premieres every year a programme with three opera titles and one zarzuela title that visits 14 Catalan cities performing 40 shows in total.



ASSOCIACIÓ TFCOOP — Art and Social Impact Hackathon (Art&Impact)

Hackathon lasting a day and a half in which 80 young people aged between 18 and 30 worked in teams to find solutions to challenges posed by various entities from the cultural and social ecosystem. All the stages of the hackathon were aligned with some technique or tool from the artistic and cultural world with the aim of encouraging creative thinking.

‘La Movida’ programme

A youth training and engagement programme to prepare educational innovation proposals in special art education (music, dance, theatre and audiovisual) that, through digital communication in new formats (TikTok and Instagram), will train young artists to later use them in online and in-person sessions in order to make innovative proposals to transform their own artistic education.

And that takes courage, because no matter how pretty we make marketing campaigns, driving change may mean being uncomfortable, but may this discomfort be blessed. B-Value Programme

B-Value is a programme that promotes the transformation of the social sector through innovation and is aimed at leaders in the third sector that work in non-profit organisations based in Spain. The aim is to work on team's leadership through the development of an innovative project from a strategic perspective, professionalise the value proposition and step away from traditional philanthropic schemes.

Design and pilot testing of a new model for career guidance based on innovative experiences, aimed at socially vulnerable young people that have failed in school. These experiences have a transformative and empowering impact on young people when choosing their academic and professional future, ensuring their emotional wellbeing in the process, and guaranteeing their continuity in their studies, thus combating early school leaving.



ÈXIT FOUNDATION — Coach programme: educational training provided by staff in companies to get young people excited about their future post-Covid

The Coach project is an initiative focused on the fight against school flunking and increasing youth employability that works on motivation to prevent early school leaving from the perspective of the company with the help of volunteers from Banco Sabadell to help them choose the right path when accessing the job market.

CIDOB and the Banco Sabadell Foundation launched the Global Talent Programme in 2020 with the aim of promoting quality research from young researchers through a paid research stay and two awards for innovative and original research works on global issues and international relations.

CÍRCULO DE BELLAS ARTES

City and Science Biennial

A highly popular science event, with strong citizen participation, which is held every other year in the city of Barcelona, at the initiative of the Barcelona City Council. As part of the scientific and cultural co-capital agreement, the 2023 Science Biennial was held for the first time in collaboration with the Madrid City Council.

“If the two cities, Madrid and Barcelona, work together, they are a powerhouse in both science and culture, and this Biennial sought to build a bridge between the two cities. The Barcelona City Council and FECYT believed that our institution was a natural partner to take the Biennial to Madrid as well. To hold the event in a cultural institution and during the ARCO week has been a sign to strengthen the interconnections between the arts, science and technology”.

Banco Sabadell's commitment to its Foundation extends to its employees, who contribute to the social programmes that we support. Their contributions are key, since they positively impact people and shape our purpose of building a fairer and more diverse society.

Throughout 2023, 118 professionals from Banco Sabadell have participated in social impact programmes of the Banco Sabadell Foundation:

- 40 volunteers from Banco Sabadell and 15 from Sabadell Seguros took part in the B-Value social innovation programme, co-promoted with the Ship2B Foundation.
